## Robbery

The University of Missouri-St. Louis Police Department has become aware of a Robbery that occurred on the UMSL South Metrolink platform. Three male suspects approached the victim on the platform stated they had a gun and demanded money. **One of the suspects was wearing a gray hoodie and gray shorts**. All three suspects ran south on the Metrolink tracks and headed west into the woods towards St Vincent County Park.

The University of Missouri-St Louis Police Department is working together with the St Louis County Police Department and the Normandy Police Department in the investigation.
