

Update - CLERY TIMELY WARNING 18-05

This is an update to Timely Warnings 18-05 for a Sexual Assault & Burglary that occurred on March 11, 2018 at University Meadows Apartments..

On Tuesday March 13, 2018 a subject was taken into custody by the St. Louis County Police Department. The St. Louis County Prosecuting Attorney's Office has issued charges for Sodomy, Burglary and Armed Criminal Action. The individual is being held on a \$500,000 cash only bond.

We would like to remind the campus community to remain vigilant in awareness of your surroundings and to follow the crime tips listed below.
